Dear Secretary Bose:

On March 30, 2018, Big Chino Valley Pumped Storage LLC (“Applicant”) filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in the above-captioned docket its Pre-Application Document (“PAD”) and Notification of Intent to file an Application for an Original License for the proposed Big Chino Valley Pumped Storage Project (“Project”). It has come to Applicant’s attention that Section 3 of the PAD included a version of Table 3-1 “*Anticipated Key Schedule Dates*” that did not reflect Applicant’s updated schedule for licensing the Project. Accordingly, Applicant hereby provides a corrected version of Section 3 of the PAD, which includes the updated Table 3-1 “*Anticipated Key Schedule Dates*”. Relatedly, in Section 1, *Introduction and Background*, the PAD states that “ITC “anticipates filing its license application in 2019.” This statement should read: “ITC anticipates filing its license application in February 2020.”

3 Process Plan and Schedule

The Project has been designated FERC number P-14859 and all Project correspondence and filings are available through FERC’s website at <https://www.ferc.gov/docs-filing/elibrary.asp>. Additionally, Project meeting dates and locations as well as major licensing documents will be posted to the Project website, www.bigchinovalleypumpedstorage.com.

Concurrently with PAD filing, ITC is requesting that FERC allow use of the Traditional Licensing Process (TLP) for the Project, as ITC believes the TLP will provide the best opportunity to engage in a licensing process that facilitates stakeholder participation, fosters collaborative decision-making, and results in a more efficient review of the Project. Parties will have 30 days from the date of PAD filing (until April 30, 2018) to submit comments on Applicant’s use of the TLP. Any comments on the request to use the TLP should address the following: (A) likelihood of timely license issuance; (B) complexity of the resource issues; (C) level of anticipated controversy; (D) relative cost of the traditional process compared to the integrated process; (E) the amount of available information and potential for significant disputes over studies; and (F) other factors believed to be pertinent.

Anticipated key dates in the Project’s licensing and development schedule are presented in Table 3-1.
